Residency

Specific fees are based on resident/non-resident status. A resident is classified as a household which pays taxes to the Village of Hawthorn Woods. This does not include all addresses listing Hawthorn Woods as the town. Please check your tax bill to verify if you are a taxpayer/resident of the Village of Hawthorn Woods. Proof of residency is required to receive this discounted rate for program registrations and daily fees. Faxed registration will be asked to provide proof of residency.

Cancellations, Withdraws, & Refunds

The Village of Hawthorn Woods strives to offer affordable and quality recreation programs. In order to ensure programs are cost-effective, the Village reserves the right to cancel class in the event of low enrollment. A 100% refund of program fees will be issued in the event a class is canceled by the Village (*).

Participants may choose to withdraw from a class prior to the start date of the class. A 15% cancellation fee will be applied to any request for a refund to withdraw from a class or program prior to the start of the first class (*). No refunds are allowed after the start of a class or program.

** Processing fees assessed through online registration are non-refundable.*

NSF Checks

A \$30 service fee will be assessed on all checks returned due to insufficient funds.

Special Recreation Association of Central Lake County (SRACLCLC)

The Village of Hawthorn Woods is a cooperative Member Agency of the Special Recreation Association of Central Lake County. SRACLCLC provides community based therapeutic recreation programs and services to people of all ages with special needs or disabilities.

SRACLCLC is a cooperative effort of the Grayslake, Vernon Hills and Mundelein Park Districts and the Villages of Hawthorn Woods, Lake Zurich, Libertyville and Lincolnshire. Individuals residing within the boundaries of the Member Agencies are considered "residents" of SRACLCLC and may utilize the services.

SRACLCLC offers more than 500 weekly programs, special events, and camps during the year. SRACLCLC also recognizes that some people with disabilities prefer to participate in recreation programs within their own Recreation Department. SRACLCLC can help you with this opportunity by providing an extra staff, if deemed necessary, behavior management support, disability awareness training, and other adaptive services necessary for safe and successful participation.






