POLICE OFFICER ALEXANDER MILLER**

WHEREAS, *Alexander Miller is a Police Officer employed by Village of Hawthorn Woods and has served the Police Department and the Hawthorn Woods community faithfully for over two years; and*

WHEREAS, *Officer Miller was on patrol on September 29, 2017 at 12:58am when he detected the odor of burning wood and observed an orange glow coming from the rear of a residence in the zero block of Heather Lane; and*

WHEREAS, *Officer Miller approached the residence to investigate further and found the deck attached to the rear of the house was engulfed in flames; and*


WHEREAS, *Officer Miller immediately requested the fire department be dispatched to the scene and began efforts to evacuate the home; and*

WHEREAS, *Officer Miller was able to wake the homeowners and safely evacuate them, their seven (7) and five (5) year old children and the family dog; and*

WHEREAS, *as a result of his quick response and immediate actions the family was safe and the responding fire departments were able to extinguish the fire before it extended into the interior of the home.*
