

ORDINANCE NO. 1825-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HAWTHORN WOODS – TITLE 9, SECTION 9-3-8 – PARKING OF CERTAIN VEHICLES PROHIBITED; EXCEPTIONS AND TITLE 11, SUBSECTION 11-1-1.F – GENERAL FEES AND CHARGES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That Title 9, Section 9-3-8 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods entitled “PARKING OF CERTAIN VEHICLES PROHIBITED; EXCEPTIONS” is hereby modified to replace subsections 9-3-8.B.1 and 9-3-8.B.2 in their entirety, and in lieu thereof, the following language shall be substituted:

...“

1. Residents – the outdoor parking of not more than one recreational vehicle, Friday through Monday, provided such parking complies with all applicable statutes and ordinances. A permit shall not be required. A recreational vehicle may be covered by a tarp or tarpaulin.
2. Non-Resident Guests – not more than two times per calendar year, the outdoor parking of not more than one (1) camping trailer, motor home, mini-motor home or van camper owned, leased or rented by a bona fide guest of the owner or tenant, for a period of not more than ten (10) consecutive days, provided a permit is obtained. A guest’s recreational vehicle may be covered by a tarp or tarpaulin.

...”

SECTION TWO: That Title 9, Section 9-3-8 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods entitled “PARKING OF CERTAIN VEHICLES PROHIBITED; EXCEPTIONS” is hereby modified to include the following subsection:

...“

9-3-8.E: Penalty

Any person violating any provision of this chapter shall be subject to penalty as provided in title 1, chapter 4 of this code for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each and every day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

...”

SECTION THREE: That Title 11, Section 11-1-1.F.9 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods entitled “Recreational Vehicle Permits” is hereby deleted in its entirety, and in lieu thereof, the following shall be substituted:

...“

9.	Recreational Vehicle Permit:		
	a.	Guest - RV	25 .00

...”

SECTION FOUR: That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, superseded by this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




