

ORDINANCE NO. 1929-19

An Ordinance Repealing “An Ordinance Providing for and Requiring the Submission of the Proposition for Increasing the Limiting Rate for the Village of Hawthorn Woods, Lake County Illinois, to the Voters of said Village at the Consolidated Election to be held on the 2nd day of April, 2019”

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, Lake County, Illinois (the “*Board*”) previously adopted Ordinance No. 1908-19, An Ordinance Providing for and Requiring the Submission of the Proposition for Increasing the Limiting Rate for the Village of Hawthorn Woods, Lake County Illinois, to the Voters of said Village at the Consolidated Election to be held on the 2nd day of April, 2019 (the “*Referendum Ordinance*”);

WHEREAS, the Office of the County Clerk of Lake County reviewed the Referendum Ordinance and raised issues about the form of the question presented;

WHEREAS, the Board decided not to submit the Referendum Ordinance to the voters due to these issues and other concerns;

WHEREAS, the Board desires to repeal the Referendum Ordinance so that the records of the Village are clear that the Referendum Ordinance was not submitted to the voters at the Consolidated Election on April 2, 2019.

NOW THEREFORE, BE It and It Is Hereby Ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The Board hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2: The Referendum Ordinance is repealed and is of no further force and effect and was not and is not to be submitted to the voters at the Consolidated Election to be held on April 2, 2019.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage and approval.
