WHEREAS, Amaya has already had the opportunity to compete in 6 different states and 3 different countries, receiving 21 medals in her various competitions; and




WHEREAS, Amaya shares her success with her Sensei Donner, who has taught her more than karate, but also discipline, respect, and improving character.
