

ORDINANCE No. 2040-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF
HAWTHORN WOODS – TITLE 3, ARTICLE 3-4B - SOLICITORS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That Title 3, Article 3-4B-3 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, entitled “CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION REQUIRED”, is hereby deleted in its entirety, and in lieu thereof, the following language shall be substituted:

...”Reserved.”

SECTION TWO: That Title 3, Article 3-4B-4 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, entitled “APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION” is hereby deleted in its entirety, and in lieu thereof, the following language shall be substituted:

...”Reserved.”

SECTION THREE: That Title 3, Article 3-4B-5 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, entitled “ISSUANCE OR DENIAL OF CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION” is hereby deleted in its entirety, and in lieu thereof, the following language shall be substituted:

...”Reserved.”

SECTION FOUR: That Title 3, Article 3-4B-10 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, entitled “PROHIBITION” is hereby deleted in its entirety, and in lieu thereof, the following language shall be substituted:

...”Reserved.”

SECTION FIVE: That Title 3, Article 3-4B-12 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, entitled “REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION” is hereby deleted in its entirety, and in lieu thereof, the following language shall be substituted:

...”Reserved.”

SECTION SIX: That Title 3, Article 3-4B-13 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, entitled “RECORDS KEPT” is here by deleted in its entirety, and in lieu thereof, the following language shall be substituted:

...”Reserved.”

SECTION SEVEN: That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, superseded by this Ordinance.

SECTION EIGHT: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


