**RESOLUTION IN MEMORY OF AL MAIDEN,
SENIOR PLANNING CONSULTANT OF HAWTHORN WOODS**

WHEREAS, in the late 1980's, Al Maiden began his service to the Village of Hawthorn Woods as a planning consultant to assist the Village with the development and growth of our community; and

WHEREAS, Al worked as the President of Rolf Campbell & Associates until his death on June 25, 2021; and

WHEREAS, in the more than three decades in which he provided planning guidance and consultation to Hawthorn Woods, Al Maiden and Rolf C. Campbell & Associates had been involved with and provided guidance on approximately 58 different subdivision developments and multiple annexations and rezoning applications in the Village of Hawthorn Woods; and

WHEREAS, in Al Maiden's service to the community, he made the greatest impact on shaping Hawthorn Woods with his reviews and recommendations to staff on a multitude of residential, office and commercial developments in the Village, as well as his work in guiding the Village towards adopting the Comprehensive Plan; and


WHEREAS, Al's impact to Hawthorn Woods also included reviewing traffic study plans, negotiating boundary agreements, commenting on various text amendments, review of zoning matters, assistance with economic development, development of various parks, serving as the consulting Community Development Director, and representing the Village at various County planning meetings regarding suburban zoning classifications and sewer in certain parts of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Al Maiden not only was a planning consultant to the Village for over 30 years, he was a mentor and friend to the employees, committee members and elected officials he served in Hawthorn Woods; and

WHEREAS, Al's hard work, dedication and genuine commitment to the Village of Hawthorn has left a profound, lasting legacy in the community in which generations to come will benefit from his tireless work for a better Hawthorn Woods.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board of Trustees, on behalf of the residents and Village staff, does hereby express its gratitude and appreciation to Al Maiden and his family for his public service faithfully performed over the past 33 years.
