

ORDINANCE NO. 2113-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HAWTHORN WOODS—TITLE 5, SECTION 5-1-1, COMPOSITION OF DEPARTMENT; TITLE 5, SECTION 5-1-2, DUTIES; AND TITLE 5, SECTION 5-1-3, SALARIES

SECTION ONE: That Title 5, Section 5-1-1 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, entitled “COMPOSITION OF DEPARTMENT”, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following language shall be substituted:

... **“5-1-1: COMPOSITION OF DEPARTMENT:**

The police department shall consist of a public safety director, chief of police, a deputy chief and such number of police officers as the mayor and board of trustees shall, from time to time, deem appropriate. The public safety director shall be appointed, discharged and/or removed by the mayor and board of trustees. The chief of police shall be appointed, discharged and/or removed in the manner set forth in section 2-11-8 of this code. The deputy chief shall be appointed, discharged and/or removed in the manner set forth in section 2-11-9 of this code. Any police officer, other than the public safety director, chief of police or deputy chief, may be dismissed, discharged or suspended in accordance with division 2.1 of article 10 of the Illinois municipal code and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder by the board of police commissioners.”

SECTION TWO: That Title 5, Section 5-1-2 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, entitled “DUTIES”, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following language shall be substituted:

... "5-1-2: DUTIES:

The public safety director and each police officer shall perform such duties as shall be prescribed by the village board for the preservation of the public peace and the observance and enforcement of the ordinances and laws of the village."

SECTION THREE: That Title 5, Section 5-1-3 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, entitled "SALARIES", is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following language shall be substituted:

... "5-1-3: SALARIES:

The salary and compensation of the public safety director and of each police officer shall be fixed by the village board."




