

ORDINANCE NO. 2196-22

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE APPROVAL AND SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR AN OPEN SPACE LAND ACQUISITION AND DEVELOPMENT (OSLAD) GRANT ADMINISTERED BY THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (IDNR) TO PROVIDE MATCHING GRANT FUNDING FOR THE RESTORATION OF WOODLAND PARK.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, Illinois, that the Mayor and Chief Operating Officer be, and the same are, hereby authorized and directed to execute and to approve submittal of a grant application for a matching grant totaling \$74,087.00 for the restoration of Woodland Park.

SECTION ONE: The preambles set forth hereinabove are incorporated herein as substantive provisions of this Ordinance as if fully set out in this Section One.


