

Notice is hereby given that the Village of Hawthorn Woods is seeking bids for 2023 Pavement Patching Program, in accordance with specifications currently on file and which may be picked up in the Village Clerk's Office at the Village of Hawthorn Woods Village Hall, located at 2 Lagoon Drive, Hawthorn Woods, Illinois 60047 between 8:00 A.M. - 4:00 P.M. Monday through Friday. The scope of the project includes approximately 1800 square yards of 4-inch thick pavement patching.

Completed bids are due in the Village Clerk's office of the Hawthorn Woods Village Hall no later than 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday, August 29, 2023, at which time said bids will be opened and publicly read aloud. The Village of Hawthorn Woods reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive technicalities or to accept any bid which, in its judgment, will be in the best interest of the public. Bids may not be modified after submittal. Bids may be withdrawn by written request at any time before the hour set for the bid opening. No bid may be withdrawn or cancelled after opening of bids for a period of thirty (30) days after the advertised closing time for the receipt of bids, nor shall the successful bid be withdrawn, cancelled or modified after having been accepted by the Village. The Village of Hawthorn Woods invites contractors to submit bids for the work described in detail in the instructions and provisions attached.

Instructions for Bids

It is the intent of the Village of Hawthorn Woods to herein specify the requirements for the installation of approximately 1800 square yards of 4-inch thick pavement patching. Contractor shall furnish all necessary labor, material and equipment for the above mentioned.

Contractors shall utilize the Contractor's Cost Sheet enclosed to indicate the cost of the project.

The successful contractor shall execute a contract with the Village and provide a certificate of insurance naming the Village of Hawthorn Woods as additional insured.

The Village of Hawthorn Woods reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities in bidding, and to accept any bid which the Board of Trustees deems most favorable to the interest of the Village.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS (PAVING CONTRACT)

1. DESCRIPTION OF SCOPE OF PROJECT

The Village has multiple streets that require 4-inch pavement patching. The streets are primarily located in the Brierwoods Estates subdivision, which includes Fox Hunt Trail, Bent Tree Court, Fox Hunt Court, as well as patching on Milton Road which is north of the neighborhood and in close proximity.

2. PAVEMENT PATCHING, 4" thickness (per square yard)

- A. Minimum thickness of 4 inches**
- B. Class D patch**

Class D patching shall conform to Section 442.08 of IDOT's Standard Specifications for Bridge and Road Construction, adopted January 1, 2022.

The HMA shall be placed only when the temperature in the shade is at least 40 °F (5 °C), the forecast is for rising temperature, and the subgrade is not frozen. The HMA shall be placed in two or more lifts with the minimum compacted thickness according to Article 406.06(d). Each lift shall be compacted with a mechanical tamper, a vibrating tamper, or a self-propelled roller.

3. KEEPING ROAD OPEN TO TRAFFIC

The roads shall be kept open to traffic at all times.

4. INCIDENTAL TO CONTRACT

Saw cutting and removal and disposal of the existing pavement and bituminous surface is incidental to this contract. Traffic control is incidental to contract.

5. PREVAILING WAGES

Successful contractor must comply with the Village of Hawthorn Woods' Prevailing Wage Rate Ordinance, as required by law. A certified payroll shall be submitted with request for payment.

6. COMPLETION DATE

The project is expected to be awarded at the September 25, 2023 Village Board meeting and all aspects of the project must be complete by October 31, 2023.

7. CONTRACTOR'S INSURANCE SPECIFICATIONS

The successful bidder shall not commence work under the contract until he/she has obtained all insurance required herein, naming the Village as additional insured party, and such insurance has been approved by the Village.

Coverage shall be at least as broad as (1) Insurance Services Office Commercial General Liability occurrence form CG 0001 (ED. 11/85) with the Village and the named as additional insured; (2) Owners and Contractors Protective Liability policy with the Village named as insured; (3) Insurance Services Office Business Auto Liability form number CA 0001 (Ed. 10/90 or newer), Symbol 01 "Any Auto"; and (4) Workers Compensation as required by the Labor Code of the State of Illinois and Employers' Liability insurance.

In the event of accidents of any kind, the successful bidder shall furnish the Village with copies of all reports of such accidents at the same time that the reports are forwarded to any other interested parties.

Any deductibles or self-insured retentions must be declared to and approved by the Village. At the option of the Village, either: the insurer shall reduce or eliminate such deductibles or self-insured retention as respects the Village, its officials, agents, employees, and volunteers; or the successful Bidder shall procure a bond guaranteeing payment of losses and related investigation, claim administration and defense expenses.

B. VERIFICATION OF COVERAGE.

The successful bidder shall furnish the Village with certificates of insurance naming the Village, its officials, agents, employees and volunteers as additional insureds, and with original endorsements effecting coverage required. The certificates and endorsements for each insurance policy are to be signed by a person authorized by that insurer to bind coverage on its behalf.

The attached Additional Insured Endorsement (Exhibit A) shall be provided to the insurer for their use in providing coverage to the additional insured. Other additional insured endorsements may be utilized, if they provide a scope of coverage at least as broad as the coverage stated on the attached endorsement (Exhibit A). The Village reserves the right to request full certified copies of the insurance policies and endorsements, which shall be provided within thirty days of the request by the Village.

C. POLICY AMENDMENTS.

Each policy shall contain, or be endorsed to contain, the following provisions:

1. **INSURED.**
(COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY AND BUSINESS AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY)

The Village, its officials, agents, employees, and volunteers are to be included as insureds with regard to liability and defense of claims arising from: (a) activities performed by or on behalf of the successful bidder, (b) products and completed operations of the successful bidder, (c) premises owned, leased or used by the successful bidder, and (d) automobiles owned, leased, hired or borrowed by the successful bidder. The coverage shall contain no special limitations on the scope of protection afforded to the Village, its officials, agents, employees, and volunteers.

2. **CONTRIBUTION NOT REQUIRED.**
(COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY AND BUSINESS AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY)

The insurance afforded by the policy shall be primary insurance as respects the Village, its officials, agents, employees, and volunteers; or stand in an unbroken chain of coverage excess of the successful bidder's scheduled underlying primary coverage. In either event, any other insurance or self-insurance maintained by the Village, its officials, agents, employees, and volunteers shall be excess of this insurance and shall not contribute with it.

3. **SEVERABILITY OF INTEREST.**
(COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY AND BUSINESS AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY)

The insurance afforded by the policy applies separately to each insured who is seeking coverage or against whom a claim is made or a suit is brought, except with respect to the Company's limit of liability.

4. **SUBCONTRACTORS.**
(ALL COVERAGES)

The successful bidder shall include all subcontractors as insured under its policies or shall furnish separate certificates and endorsements for each subcontractor. All coverages for subcontractors shall be subject to all of the requirements stated in this Section.

5. **PROVISIONS REGARDING THE INSURED'S DUTIES AFTER ACCIDENT OR LOSS.**

Any failure to comply with reporting provisions of the policy shall not affect coverage provided to the Village, its officials, agents, employees, and volunteers.

6. **CANCELLATION NOTICE.**
(ALL COVERAGES)

The insurance afforded by the policy shall not be suspended, voided, canceled, reduced in coverage or in limits except after thirty (30) days' prior written notice by certified mail return receipt requested has been given to the Village. Such notice shall be addressed as shown in the heading of the endorsement.

7. **INDEMNITY/HOLD HARMLESS PROVISIONS.**

The insurance afforded by the policy shall include the "Indemnity Hold Harmless" provisions set forth below.







TO: All Prospective Bid Holders of Record

BY THIS NOTICE, the Village of Hawthorn Woods hereby amends the referenced project request for bidding documents as follows:

1. Replace 1. **DESCRIPTION OF SCOPE OF PROJECT** in its entirety and replace with the following:

1. DESCRIPTION OF SCOPE OF PROJECT

The Village has multiple streets that require 4-inch pavement patching. The streets are primarily located in the Brierwoods Estates subdivision, which include Fox Hunt Trail, Pheasant Run, Winding Branch and possibly other neighborhood streets, as well at patching on Milton Road which is north of the neighborhood and in close proximity.

2. Replace 2.A. in its entirety and replace with the following: "Minimum thickness of 4 inches with 1.75" surface course and 2.25" binder course."
3. Add 2.C. **PAVEMENT PATCHING**
 - C. Patches are expected to be 5' in width or larger.
4. Add 2.D. **PAVEMENT PATCHING**
 - D. Approximately 20% to 30% of the patching is expected to be on Milton Road with the remaining in the Brierwoods Estates subdivision.
5. Add the following paragraphs:

7. STRIPING
Some of the work on Milton Road will affect the center line and edge striping. The contractor is not responsible for striping. The Village will have it striped after the patching work is complete.

8. EXAMINATION OF PROJECT
The Village has marked the areas with paint that are expected to be included in the project in order to provide an approximate scope of work for the project to contractors. Additional square yards may be added in this neighborhood depending on bids.


