

ORDINANCE NO. 2305-24

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HAWTHORN WOODS—TITLE 3, SUBSECTION 3-10-5.A—FOOD AND BEVERAGE TAX; AND AMENDING TITLE 11, SUBSECTION 11-1-1.F.19—VENDOR FEES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That Title 3, Subsection 3-10-5.A of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods is hereby deleted in its entirety, and in lieu thereof the following language shall be substituted:

“A. In lieu of a food and beverage tax, due to the temporary and transient nature of temporary food and beverage vendors, such vendors shall be charged a flat fee as set forth in the fee schedule as established and amended from time to time by the Village Board. This section will not apply to any retailer who also maintains a retail food facility or retail liquor facility in the Village of Hawthorn Woods and files returns in accordance with this chapter.”

SECTION TWO: That Title 11, Subsection 11-1-1.F.19 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods is hereby deleted in its entirety, and in lieu thereof the following language shall be substituted:

d. Holiday Craft Fair	
(1) Cost Per Table	\$85.00
(2) Cost Per Table Including Electricity	Additional \$20.00

(3) Cost Per Table Including Wi-Fi Access	Additional \$10.00
e. Home Town Holiday	
(1) Vendor	\$75.00
(2) Promotional Vendor	\$50.00
f. Party In The Park	
(1) Vendor - Hawthorn Woods Business	\$150.00
(2) Vendor - Non-Hawthorn Woods Business	\$200.00
g. Vendor fees may be lowered at the discretion of the Chief Operating Officer”	

SECTION THREE: That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, superseded by this Ordinance.


