A RESOLUTION IN APPRECIATION OF DAVID LINDQUIST FOR HIS YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE VILLAGE OF HAWTHORN WOODS AS A MEMBER OF THE PLANNING, BUILDING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS

WHEREAS, David Lindquist and his wife Barbara have resided in the Village of Hawthorn Woods since 1969, where they raised their three sons, Scot, Erik and Mark, and proudly serve as grandparents to 13 and great-grandparents to five with four more great-grandchildren on the way; and

WHEREAS, Dave and Barbara were initially drawn to the Village of Hawthorn Woods because of the natural beauty, open space and respect for the environment they saw; and

WHEREAS, after earning his architectural degree from the University of Illinois, and being a registered structural engineer and certified architect, Mr. Lindquist believed he could provide assistance to the Village of Hawthorn Woods with his knowledge about development and construction; and

WHEREAS, in 1989, under the leadership of Village President Glen Grieshaber, Mr. Lindquist was first appointed to the Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals in October 1989, he became the chairperson of the Plan Commission on March 2, 1995, and he served in both capacities until February 8, 2007 at which time he briefly retired; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lindquist served the community at his first Plan Commission meeting on November 2, 1989 in which that evening, the Commission heard requests for a special use permit for a berm on N. Trail, considered an annexation agreement on the Bruns property, reviewed the concept plan for the Hawthorn Woods Business Park, recommended acceptance of a revised preliminary plat for the Glens of Stone Creek, and approved the final plat for Sacomano Meadows; and

WHEREAS, after a brief hiatus, on August 17, 2009, Mr. Lindquist came out of retirement to once again serve the Village of Hawthorn Woods as a member of the Planning, Building and Zoning Commission; and

WHEREAS, over the years as a Zoning Board of Appeals member and Plan Commissioner, Mr. Lindquist participated in numerous meetings and public hearings regarding potential developments, and made recommendations to the Village Board that would eventually shape the Village to what it is today; and


WHEREAS, of the many projects Mr. Lindquist heard, he has said he is most proud of the Village's insistence that the stormwater basin at Heritage Oaks Park be moved to save a grove of oak trees for the enjoyment of generations to come, and the use of concrete ribbons as opposed to curbs to address the natural flow of stormwater into the roadway ditches; and

WHEREAS, after more than 34 years of dedicated service, Mr. Lindquist has decided to retire as a member of the Planning, Building and Zoning Commission; and


