

ORDINANCE No. 2401-24

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO BE ELECTED IN AND AFTER 2025 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL CODE AND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICER COMPENSATION ACT

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Section 3.1-50-5 of the Illinois Municipal Code provides that the salaries or other compensation of all municipal officers shall be fixed by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.1-50-10 of the Illinois Municipal Code and Section 2 of the Local Government Officer Compensation Act provide that the salaries or other compensation of the elected officers must be fixed at least 180 days prior to the commencement of the terms of the officers whose compensation is to be fixed; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board desires to set the compensation of the Mayor and Village Trustees elected to a full term of office at the consolidated general election of April 1, 2025, and the Mayor and Village Trustees elected to full terms thereafter.

WHEREAS, the commencement of the terms of said officers will not occur fewer than 180 days after the effective date of this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, Illinois, that:

1. Effective June 1, 2025, the annual salary of the Mayor shall be \$12,500.
2. Effective June 1, 2025, the annual salary of each Village Trustee shall be \$5,000.
3. Effective June 1, 2025, the Mayor and each Village Trustee may enroll in any individual or family health, dental and vision insurance plans offered to Village employees on the same terms available to Village employees, provided that the Mayor and each Village Trustee shall be responsible for the full cost of such plans, including the portion thereof paid by the Village in the case of an employee.
4. Effective May 15, 2025, the Mayor and each Village Trustee shall be entitled to one non-transferable family pass annually for the Village's Aquatic Center.

BE IT ORDAINED that the salaries or other compensation set forth in this Ordinance shall not be available to any Village Trustee holding office by virtue of election in 2023 for a four-year term, or to any trustee appointed to complete such a term, but shall be available to the Mayor and any Village Trustee elected to a full term of office on or after April 1, 2025; and

BE IT ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.


