

ORDINANCE No. 2484-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HAWTHORN WOODS – LIQUOR LICENSES –TITLE 3, SECTION 3-3-8—LICENSE CLASSIFICATIONS; TITLE 3, SECTION 3-3-10—NUMBER OF LICENSES; AND TITLE 11, SECTION 11-1-1—FEES FOR CERTAIN ACTIVITIES AND PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That Title 3, Section 3-3-8 of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, is hereby amended by adding the following language after Class B:

..."B-1:Class B-1: Shall permit the retail sale of original packaged alcoholic liquor at gas stations, but not for consumption on the licenses premises where sold, except as otherwise permitted in conjunction with video gaming as fully set forth below in this paragraph, as well as the retail sale of beer and wine for consumption on the specified premises. This license allows the retail sale of original packaged alcoholic liquor with the allowance of serving beer and wine for consumption on the premises for the primary purpose of accommodating statutorily authorized video gaming machines. Consumption on premises shall be confined and limited to the restricted area immediately surrounding the gaming machines as identified in the license application. Beverages for purchase in conjunction with video gaming will be kept behind the counter. Patrons will not be allowed to purchase alcohol from the gas station coolers or shelves for consumption on-site."

SECTION TWO: That Title 3, Section 3-3-8.H.1. of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods is hereby deleted in its entirety, and the following language shall be substituted:

SECTION FOUR: That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, superseded by this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
