

ORDINANCE NO. 2500-25

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE VILLAGE OF HAWTHORN WOODS
ACCESSIBILITY CODE:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village of Hawthorn Woods to adopt the current Illinois Accessibility Code, 2018 Edition as and for the Village of Hawthorn Woods Accessibility Code with the amendments contained herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 8-1-9 of the Hawthorn Woods Municipal Code is hereby deleted and replaced by the following:

...“

8-1-9: ACCESSIBILITY CODE:

A. Rules And Regulations: The rules and regulations set forth in the current Illinois Accessibility Code, State of Illinois, Capital Development Board, 1997 edition, are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this title, with amendments prescribed in subsection B of this section, as the rules and regulations of the Village; and it shall be unlawful for any person to construct, install, alter or repair, or cause to be constructed, installed, altered or repaired, any public facilities or multi-story housing units in the Village in violation of or without complying with those rules and regulations. At least three (3) copies of said pamphlet have been filed in the Office of the Village Clerk for use and examination by the public.

B. Amendments To Code: The following amendments to the Illinois Accessibility Code are hereby made a part of these regulations:

The stricter of the requirements shall apply when there is a conflict between the Illinois accessibility code and Chapter 11 of the International Building Code.

...”

SECTION TWO: That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, superseded by this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: If any section, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be found invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder of this ordinance, but only that part found invalid by such court.

SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.


