

ORDINANCE NO. 2501-25

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE VILLAGE OF HAWTHORN WOODS
ILLINOIS ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village of Hawthorn Woods to adopt the current Illinois Energy Conservation Code as and for the Village of Hawthorn Woods Energy Code with the amendments contained herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 8-1-10 of the Hawthorn Woods Municipal Code is hereby created with the following:

...“

8-1-10 – ENERGY CODE

This section shall be known and cited as the Hawthorn Woods Energy Code.

A – ENERGY CODE CREATED

There is created and established, in and for the Village of Hawthorn Woods, the Hawthorn Woods Energy Code.

B – ADOPTION OF THE NATIONAL ENERGY CODE

The Illinois Energy Conservation Code as issued and promulgated by the National Fire Protection Association and approved by the American National Standards Institute, a copy of which have been on file with the Village Clerk’s office and the Community Development Department for at least thirty (30) days prior hereto, and open to public inspection, is hereby adopted by reference and incorporated herein in its entirety. Said Illinois Energy Conservation Code is hereby adopted as the rules and regulations for construction, alteration, addition, modification, & repair with amendments, modifications and additions as herein set forth in the

Village of Hawthorn Woods, Lake County, Illinois, and shall be applicable to existing or proposed new buildings or structures.

..."

SECTION TWO: That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, superseded by this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: If any section, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be found invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder of this ordinance, but only that part found invalid by such court.

SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.


