



MAILBOX REGULATIONS

In Accordance with Village Code

- The address identified by Arabic numerals, at least four inches (4") high, must be placed on the side of the box from which the carrier approaches for single mailboxes.
- The street number for buildings on corner lots shall be placed so as to be visible from the street from which the lot takes access to and from the village street system.
- Residents are responsible for the removal of snow, debris or any obstructions that may prevent the carrier from delivering their mail to their box without leaving the vehicle.
- Mailboxes must be securely attached to posts to prevent separation if struck.
- Since the location of mailboxes is in the Village's right-of-way, any damage to mailboxes due to Village snowplowing operations will result in the Public Works Department repairing the mailbox, if possible. If repair is not possible, the Village will replace the damaged mailbox with a standard mailbox and post. Front of mailbox must be 6 to 12 inches back from edge of roadway



Bottom of mailbox must be 42 to 48 inches from roadway surface
