DIY CRAFT CORNER

Clothespin Flower Pot

You will need:

- Old can of tuna fish (no lid)
- Wood clothespins
- Glue

How to make:

- Clean the tuna can with soap and water. Remove any wrapping or glue from the can's surface.
- Open a clothespin and place a dot of glue on the inside of each tip.
- Place the clothespins on the tuna can as shown in the lower picture.
- Plant seeds to grow or place a silk plant inside.
- Suggestion: Paint the clothespin to match your decor. You can even add glitter.

RECIPE

Sweet Tea Barbeque Chicken


Ingredients:

- 1 cup of unsweetened apple juice
- 1 cup water
- 1 teaspoon of paprika
- 1 teaspoon of garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon coarsely ground pepper
- 2 teaspoons of seafood seasoning
- 8 boneless chicken breasts
- BBQ sauce
- Grape jelly
- Sweet tea



How to make:

- Pre heat oven to 350 degrees.
- Pour apple juice and water into a large shallow roasting pan and stir together.
- Mix paprika, garlic powder, and seafood seasoning together in a separate bowl.
- Rub spices over boneless chicken breast pieces.
- Place in the roasting pan and cover with foil.
- Bake in the oven, covered, until juices run clear and thermometer reads 170-175. It should take about 45 to 60 minutes depending on your oven.
- Transfer chicken to a foil lined 15x10x1-in baking pan.
- Pour BBQ sauce into a bowl. Add sweet tea and splash of grape jelly and whisk briskly.
- Brush some of the mixture over chicken (remember to leave some for applying on the grill).
- Place Chicken on the grill, grill over medium heat 3 to 5 minutes per side. Remember to brush occasionally with your remaining homemade sauce.
