

Cooking with Kids Recipe

Funfetti Popsicles

Ingredients:

- 2 cups plain Greek yogurt
- ¼ cup honey or maple syrup
- 3 tablespoons of milk
- ¼ teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/3 cup sprinkles
- Popsicle molds
(or dixie cups with popsicle sticks)

How to make:

- In a medium bowl, mix together the yogurt, honey, milk, and vanilla extract until completely smooth.
- Add in ¼ cup of sprinkles and mix until combined.
- Spoon the mixture into the popsicle molds.
- Add the rest of the sprinkles on top of the yogurt.
- Insert the popsicle sticks.
- Freeze for at least 4 hours or until frozen.
- Note: You can use vanilla Greek yogurt instead of plain Greek yogurt.

Animal Suncatchers

What you will need:

- Coffee filters
- Water color paints
- Paint brush
- Glue
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Construction paper
- Clear tape



How to make:

- Paint the coffee filter and set it out to dry.
- Use the pencil to draw or trace an animal pattern on construction paper.
- Cut the animal out of the paper.
- Glue the animal to the coffee filter.
- Tape the suncatcher to the window.

Sponge Bullseye

What you will need:

- Sponges
- Bucket
- Water
- Sidewalk chalk

How to play:

- On the driveway or sidewalk, draw circles with chalk to create the bullseye shape.
- List a point value for each circle, highest number should be the middle circle (ex: count by 10's to fill in the circles).
- Stand at the edge of the most outer circle, take a minimum of three steps away from the circle, and draw a throw line.
- Fill the bucket with water.
- Dip the sponges into the bucket and soak the sponges.
- Taking turns, throw the sponges to see who can get the highest number.

Fly a Kite


What you will need:

- Kite
- Windy day

Head outside and enjoy summer while flying a kite. Check the wind before trying to fly your kite. Kites don't fly well when there is too little or too much wind. The best places to fly kites are the beach, park, or an open field where there are no trees, roads, power lines, buildings, or other things that block the wind.



Have someone help you get your kite in the air. One person holds the string spool and the other person holds the kite from a distance apart. Hold the kite in the air and let the wind launch it. This is called a long launch. You should not have to run to get the kite into the air.



Hopscotch



What you will need:


- Chalk

How to play:


- Get out the colored chalk and draw a huge hopscotch path. Add extra fun by trading traditional hopscotch square shapes for cars, butterflies, fish, and other fun designs.
- Throw a small stone, twig, beanbag, or other marker into the first square.
- If it lands on a line, or outside the square, you lose your turn. Pass the marker to the following player and wait for your next turn.
- Hop on one foot into the first empty square, and then every subsequent empty square. Be sure to skip the one your marker is on. If you fall, jump outside the lines, or miss a square or the marker, you lose your turn and must repeat the same number on your next turn.
- Whoever reaches to ten (10) first, wins.
