# DIY CRAFT CORNER

## Mosquito Repellent Candles

You will need:

- Pint mason jars
- Floating candles
- 1 lemon
- 1 lime
- Water
- Basil
- Lemongrass essential oil

How to make:

- Lay the lemon lengthwise and slice into circles.
- Repeat with the lime.
- Add a few slices of lemon and lime to lay flat at the bottom of the jar.
- Add a couple sprigs of basil.
- Fill the jar with water, leaving 1-2 inches of space from the top.
- Add in 10-15 drops of lemongrass oil.
- Stir.
- Add the floating candle.
- Light the candle and enjoy a mosquito free summer!
- Note: This can make approximately two candles when using one lemon and one lime.

# RECIPE

## Chocolate Chip Cookie Dough Dip

### Ingredients:


- 1/2 cup unsalted butter
- 1/3 cup brown sugar
- A pinch of salt
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 8 ounces cream cheese
- 1/2 cup powdered sugar
- 3/4 cup semisweet mini chocolate chips
- Serve with: Graham crackers, Nilla wafers, fruit, or any other dipping foods you like.
- Small saucepan
- Electric mixer
- Medium size bowl



### How to make:

- In a small saucepan, melt the butter, brown sugar and salt over medium-low heat, stirring until the brown sugar dissolves.
- Remove from heat and whisk in the vanilla extract.
- Set aside and cool to room temperature.
- With an electric mixer on medium speed, beat the cream cheese and powdered sugar for 1 minute, or until smooth and fluffy.
- Reduce the mixer speed to low and slowly beat in the cooled butter mixture. Increase the speed to medium and beat for one minute.
- Stir in the chocolate chips.
- Transfer the dip into a serving bowl and refrigerate for 15-30 minutes before serving.

Relaxing in the great outdoors is a great way to spend Father's Day. Even in your backyard, Dad will appreciate time with the family. This is especially fun if you have little ones.


