



Cooking with Kids Recipe

Dinosaur Snack Mix

Ingredients:

- Popcorn (pre-popped or kernels)
- Mini pretzels
- Bugles
- Dinosaur cheddar crackers
- Dinosaur gummies
- Medium bowl



How to make:

- Pop the popcorn.
- Add all the ingredients into the medium bowl.
- Mix together carefully with your hands.
- Notes: Dinosaur items don't have to be dinosaurs. If this mix isn't eaten right away, store in an airtight container for up to three days.

Camping Lantern Craft

What you will need:

- 1 clean clear plastic bottle
- 1 sheet of yellow tissue paper
- Small strip of green tissue paper
- Mod Podge glue
- 2 pipe cleaners
- Electric candle or glowsticks
- Paintbrush

How to make:

- Tear up the yellow tissue paper into small pieces. Set them aside.
- Use the paint brush to cover the outside of the plastic bottle in Mod Podge.
- Put the yellow pieces of tissue paper on the bottle (in no particular order).
- Put some Mod Podge on your brush and coat the top portion of the container.
- Add green tissue paper to that area.
- Using the Mod Podge and the brush, glue down any edges sticking out. The whole bottle should be smooth.
- Add any extra decor.
- Wrap one of the pipe cleaners tightly around the opening of the container.
- Use the other pipe cleaner to create a handle.
- Attach both sides of the handle pipe cleaner to the circle pipe cleaner at the base of the opening.
- Drop in the electric candle or glowsticks.
- Notes: Smooth, clear plastic bottles work the best. Add extra decor such as animal silhouettes, stickers, glitter, etc. Decorate the handle using beads.


Dinosaur Skeleton

What you will need:

- Q-tips
- Glue
- Construction Paper

How to make:

Make a skeleton of your favorite dinosaur. Grab some q-tips, glue and put together your very own dinosaur fossil. Use construction paper as a base for your fossil and glue the q-tips to the construction paper to make your fossil.



Dinosaur Masks

What you will need:

- Paper plates
- Coloring utensils
- Scissors
- Glue
- Construction paper

How to make:

Become your favorite dinosaur by creating a dinosaur mask. Use a paper plate and cut out holes for your eyes and mouth. Then decorate your mask however you like. Give your dinosaur teeth, horns or scales. Be creative!



Dinosaur Fossils

What you will need:

- 2 cups flour
- 1 cup salt
- ½ cup warm water
- Plastic dinosaurs
- Plastic dinosaur skeletons
- Medium bowl
- Wooden spoon

How to make:

- Mix the flour, salt, and warm water together to make the salt dough.
- Make a small ball of dough, then press it flat with the palm of your hand.
- Gently press a dinosaur skeleton toy into the dough.
- Gently lift the toy up to reveal a cool impression.
- Line up the “fossils” on a baking sheet.
- Bake on 250 degrees for 1-2 hours.
- Remove once they are hard.
- Notes: Use wheat flour to make a darker dough that looks more natural.
- A fun way to play: Bury these fossils in the yard, around the neighborhood, or in the sandbox. Practice being a real paleontologist uncovering these fossils!






Virtual Tour of the Smithsonian
